**Custom Porcelain Veneers Esthetic**

Custom porcelain veneers are among the most difficult procedures we perform. We have had excellent success with this process over the past fifteen years; however, the ultimate success longevity is unknown. As discussed, some enamel is buffed prior to veneering so the procedure is not reversible. Some patients experience sensitivity from veneer placement that is usually transient but may result in the need for additional treatment. In masking discolorations, it is not uncommon for some of the discoloration to "bleed" through at the gumline of the veneer. This cannot be predictably avoided. In rare instances, it may not be possible to retain the veneer(s) and an alternate (complete coverage) procedure could be required. Veneers are artificial tooth surface replacements and may have some minor "flaws" or "imperfections" upon close inspection. These restorations are not indestructible, and you should not use your teeth as "tools".
